To every athlete here, thank you for making the journey, for those who've travelled from within our great country, or for some, even further.

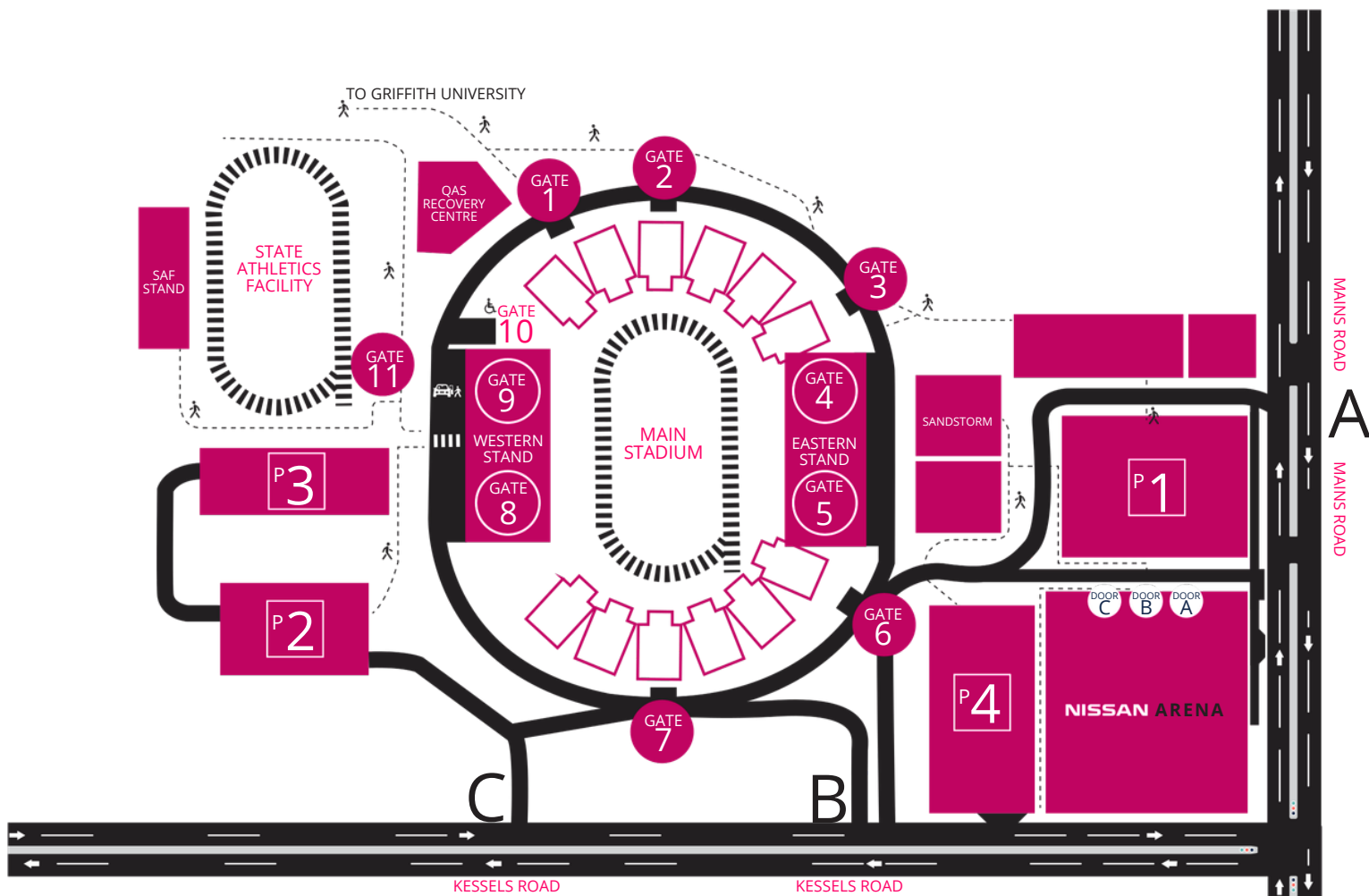
I hope the competition is fierce, the sportsmanship is outstanding, and that you leave Brisbane proud of what you've been part of.

GETTING THERE

Driving:

Nissan Arena has on-site parking available, including a large car park for players and spectators. Parking is generally free, but it can fill up during major event, arriving early is recommended.

Public Transport:

The venue is well connected via Brisbane public transport:

- Bus: Multiple bus routes service Mains Road with stops close to the arena.
- Train: The closest stations are Altandi and Sunnybank, followed by a short bus or rideshare trip.

ON SITE FACILITIES

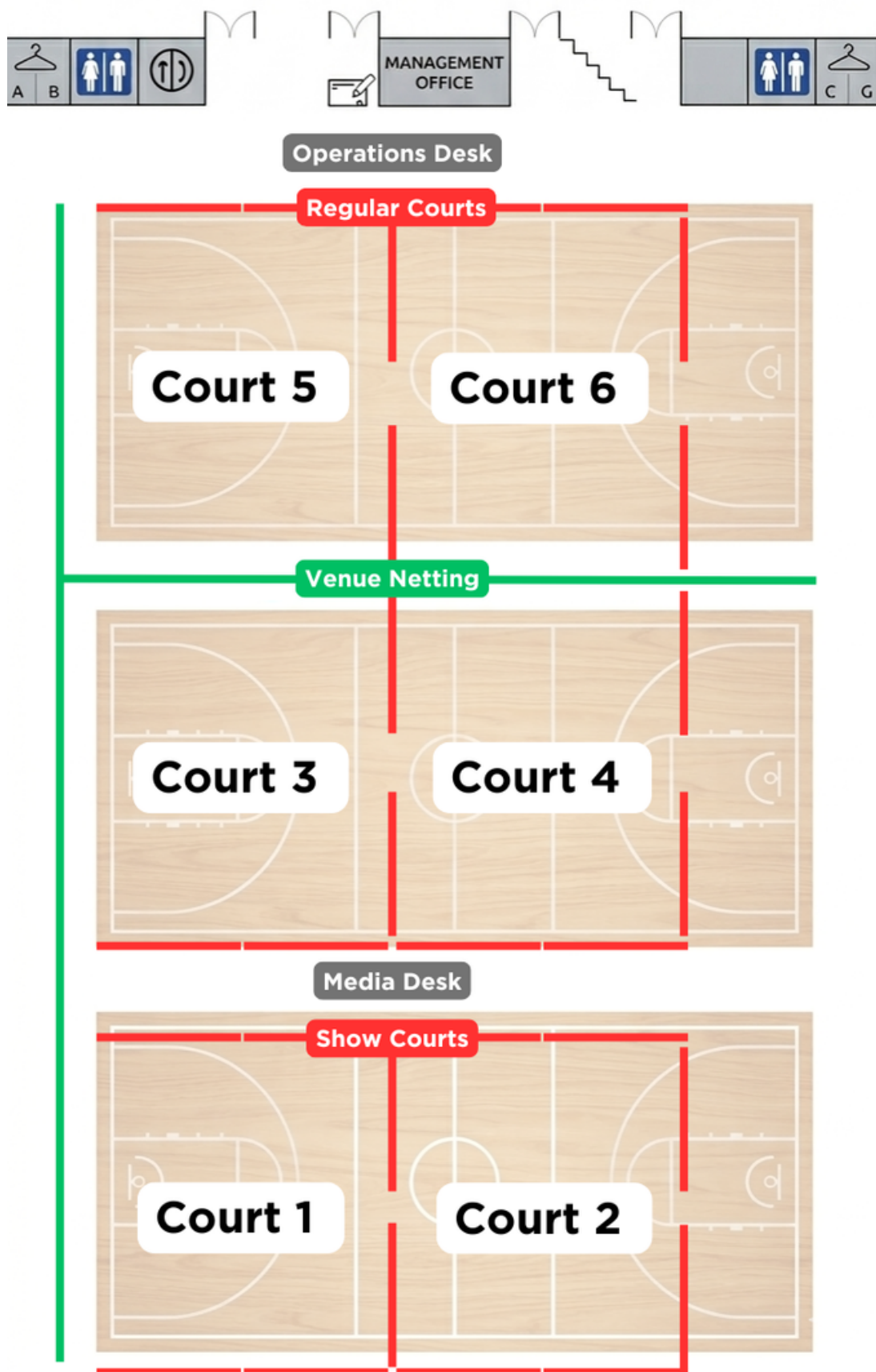
- Full toilet, shower, and changing room facilities are available for players.

DAYS 1 & 2- PRELIM & ELIM MATCHES

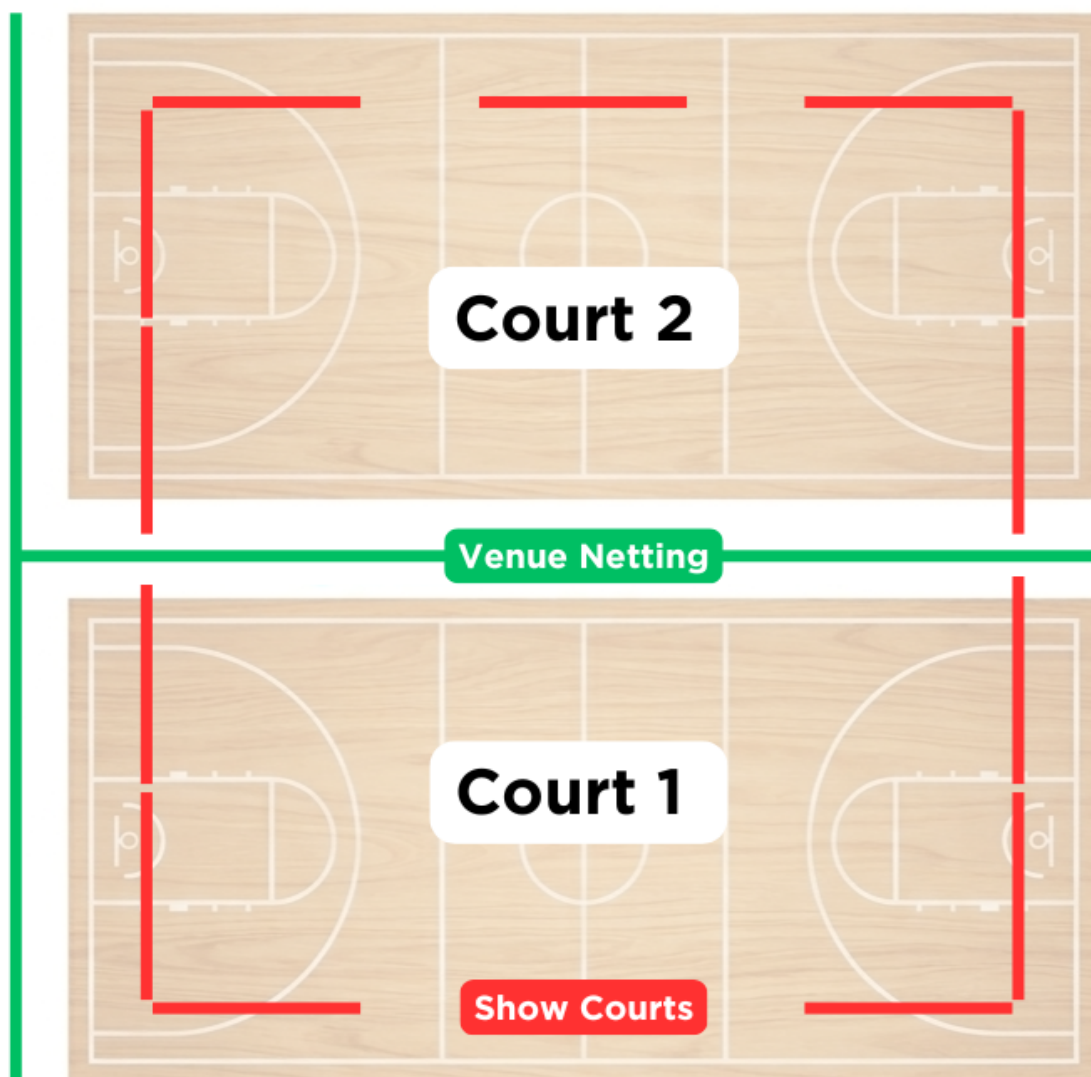


VENUE DIAGRAM

CONDUCT

All players taking part in the Australian Dodgeball Championships are required to adhere to the Australian Dodgeball Federation's Code of Conduct, Member Protection Policy and ADC Misconduct Policy.

MAINTAIN GAME TIME SCHEDULE

To ensure all matches on Day 1 and Day 2 can be played to their entirety, keeping to the fixture schedule will be essential. We ask that all athletes arrive at their games with satisfactory time to warm-up, prepare and begin at their scheduled time. Penalties may apply to teams that are late to their game times.

COURT SAFETY

To maintain the safety and quality of our playing surfaces, no non-playing equipment may be brought within the court netting space. This includes but is not limited to personal water bottles, chalk tubs/tubes or food. Athletes/teams may be asked to remove items at the match referee and ADF staff's discretion.

PAYMENTS

Teams are expected to be financially compliant prior to the tournament. Teams who have not fully paid their registrations will be unable to play.

EVENT ASSISTANCE

There may be situations that arise where we call upon athletes to assist in minor tasks to assist in the running of the event. These will be done so with the utmost respect to athlete's match obligations and schedules and only done so when essential.
